HOUSING: A Gorgeous Mansion in the Capitol City

Housing is available at the beautiful and historic Llewellyn Williams Mansion, operated by Hostelling International at 925 H St. (10th and H) in downtown Sacramento. Check it out online, but don't register with them, register through us. <http://www.norcalhostels.org/sac>

The mansion has dorm style rooms, which are spacious and comfortable, sleeping from 5 to 9 persons. There are a few smaller rooms available on a "first-registered" basis. Clean bedding is provided. The Mansion does not allow sleeping bags, pets, alcohol; smoking is outside in designated areas only. There is no elevator to the second or third floors (stairs only). Wheelchair accessible accommodations are available in dorm rooms, and in the first floor suite.
