

# Driving Directions

Although our mailing address is in Walnut Grove, we are not actually IN Walnut Grove, but on the other side of Grand Island, on Steamboat Slough at 13737 Grand Island Road (916) 775-4021 nursery, (916) 775-4545 ecotours.

**The brief description of where we are: 2.7 miles north of the intersection of Hwy. 220 and Grand Island Road OR 3.7 miles south of the intersection of Hwy. 160 and Grand Island Road.**

Following are regional driving directions...there are many ways to get here from there!

## **From Sacramento via I-5 South**

1. Exit at Twin Cities Rd., turning RIGHT (west) and taking Twin Cities until it ends at the River Road.
2. At River Road (stop sign), turn LEFT, heading towards Locke and Walnut Grove.
3. In Walnut Grove at the four-way stop, turn RIGHT to cross the bridge over Sacramento River.
4. On other side of bridge (Grand Island), turn LEFT onto Hwy. 160, heading south to Ryde.
5. At Ryde, turn RIGHT onto Hwy. 220, taking 220 West to the other side of the island.
6. When you reach the intersection of Hwy. 220 and Grand Island Road, bear RIGHT back up onto levee - Hartland is 2.7 miles from this intersection.

## **From Stockton via I-5 North**

1. I-5 North towards Walnut Grove, exit Thornton-Walnut Grove Exit, turning LEFT (west).
2. Stay on Walnut Grove-Thornton Road for about five miles - crossing two bridges that are in-line with the road.
3. In Walnut Grove at the four-way stop, turn LEFT to cross the bridge over Sacramento River.
4. On other side of bridge (Grand Island), turn LEFT onto Hwy. 160, heading south to Ryde.
5. At Ryde, turn RIGHT onto Hwy. 220, taking 220 West to the other side of the island.
6. When you reach the intersection of Hwy. 220 and Grand Island Road, bear RIGHT back up onto levee - Hartland is 2.7 miles from this intersection.

### **From the East Bay Area via Highway 24**

1. Highway 24 East towards Walnut Creek
2. Merge onto I-680 N via exit on the LEFT toward Concord/Sacramento
3. Merge onto Highway 242 North on the LEFT toward Concord/Pittsburg
4. Merge onto Highway 4 East via the exit on the LEFT toward Stockton/Pittsburg
5. Merge onto Highway 160 North (this direction over the Antioch Bridge is \$4.00 toll).
6. Pass through Isleton – North of Isleton is the Isleton Bridge – turn LEFT to cross the bridge (onto Grand Island), then right back onto Highway 160 North.
7. At Ryde, take Highway 220 West to other side of Grand Island
8. At the intersection of Highway 220 and Grand Island Road, bear right. Hartland is 2.7 miles from this intersection.

### **From Highway 12, Near I-80/Fairfield**

1. Take Highway 12 East towards Rio Vista.
2. Pass through Rio Vista, crossing the bridge that will take you to the intersection of Hwy 160 and Hwy 12. There is a stop light.
3. Turn LEFT onto Hwy 160 heading towards Isleton.
4. Pass through Isleton – North of Isleton is the Isleton Bridge – turn LEFT to cross the bridge (onto Grand Island), then right back onto Highway 160 North.
5. At Ryde, take Highway 220 West to other side of Grand Island
6. At the intersection of Highway 220 and Grand Island Road, bear right. Hartland is 2.7 miles from this intersection.

A few additional comments to help make your visit to the delta more pleasant: Islands of the delta are connected by a series of bridges and ferries. The bridges sometimes have limited sight distance, so please exercise caution when approaching as there may be wide vehicles (such as farming equipment) attempting to navigate across a bridge. Cell phone coverage is often unreliable and we've received calls from folks that are attempting to drive the levee road while on the phone - probably not a good idea for two reasons. There is a river on one side of the levee and phone reception may fade. And, although we accept credit cards for your nursery and ecotour purchases, there are a number of businesses in the delta that only accept cash - don't leave home without it!
