

# Bring Health Reform Home:

## June Deadline for Passage of Six CA Health Care Implementation Bills

Six California legislative bills need to pass through health committees by the end of June to implement health care reform. In order to bring health care reform home to CA we have work to do this summer. We need to learn about these bills, share our passion for reform, and respond with letters, calls, and legislative visits.

Here are six health care bills to support for implementing health care reform in California that have passed one chamber of the Legislature. They will need to be passed by the Health committee of the other chamber by the end of June, and by the entire other chamber this summer.

The CA Senate Health Committee passed all the bills in front of them on June 24, 2010.

Right now the Senate bills (SB) are in the Assembly Health Committee and their vote is June 29, 2010.

You do not need to be in the district of those on the Health Committees. Call all of them and ask to vigorously support the bills below.

**SB 900(Alquist/Steinberg)** CREATING A CALIFORNIA HEALTH INSURANCE EXCHANGE: Would establish the California Health Insurance Exchange within the California Health and Human Services Agency to make health coverage available and create the California Health Insurance Exchange Fund to be governed by a board appointed by the Legislature.

**SB890 (Alquist/Steinberg)** TRANSITIONING TO A MORE TRANSPARENT & STANDARDIZED MARKET: Standardizes and simplifies the individual insurance market. Reforms the insurance market to standardize benefits, make plans more transparent, and provide a range of consumer protections, preventing cherry picking by companies. [UULM Review of SB890]

**SB 810 (Leno)** CA Single Payer Coverage.
